Opening hours: The main building is open from 8:00 till 20:00.

ID cards: To get your ID card, you should come to the Study Dept to have your picture taken. You'll receive your permanent plastic card in a few weeks' time.

Czech language courses: Intensive language courses for foreign students (12 lessons of 90min) are available on the demand basis. Because the school has to hire a special teacher for such course, extra costs have to be involved. Therefore such course is set up with a minimum of 5 paying students (100 Euros for the whole course), full-timers or exchange students.
